Sub: KUHS - Exam General (A) - Implementation of Frisking at the entrance of examination hall during University Examinations - Modified instructions - reg.

The Malpractices & Lapses Enquiry Committee (M&LEC) has observed a rise in the possession and use of mobile phones and other prohibited items including electronic gadgets by candidates during University Examination. To curb the use of such items and in light of Government restrictions vide referred 3rd above on the installation of mobile jammers in some institutions, instructions were issued as referred 2nd above to ensure effective monitoring and to maintain sanctity of the examination process.

Considering the representations from various organizations and stakeholders, the circular referred 2nd above is modified to the extent as follows;

1. The QP downloading room/ Confidential room and examination hall shall be declared as '**Mobile Free Zones**' and this shall be appropriately displayed outside the aforementioned locations.
2. The Chief Superintendent shall ensure that an announcement has been made before the candidates are permitted inside the examination hall, instructing to remove all electronic items including mobile phones, which will help to prevent the candidates from bringing these items inadvertently into the examination hall.
3. Before the commencement of each University theory examination, frisking of candidates, if necessary, shall be done at the entrance of the examination hall so as to ensure that candidates are not in possession of any of the items prohibited to be taken into the examination hall.
4. Frisking when done, has to be undertaken separately for male and female students by male and female staff only respectively.
5. Frisking can be undertaken either by teaching faculty or other staff involved in examination duties who are entrusted for the same by the Chief Superintendent.

The circular aims to make the examination process false proof and to ensure that honest students are





not put at a disadvantage. In view of the above, all affiliated institutions are directed to make necessary arrangements to implement these instructions with immediate effect. Principals/ Chief Superintendent shall ensure strict adherence .
