- Please support the District Health authorities if they request for any activity that are meant to prevent the spread of COVID 19. Such activity will be appreciated and recognized by the University and considered equal to attending classes.

Let us join hands with the Government and all others in the fight to prevent this pandemic and save our brothers and sisters.
